Note any common errors to avoid or	
discriminations to understand:	
the results cannot be absolutely applied	
(generalized) to the couple. Each person	
and thus each couple are unique. These	
results, based on the national sample of	
nearly 22,000 couples, provide a good	
beginning point to better understand the	
dynamics of the couple; yet the	
uniqueness of each couple needs to be	
understood. It is imperative to allow the	
man and the woman to own the results of	
the inventory. Identified issues and	
strengths may not be pertinent for this	
specific couple based upon what they	
desire for their relationship. The ability	
to apply these results appropriately to a	
couple is the art and skill of a	
knowledgeable and experienced	
professional counselor.	
The students need to know how to	
apply these measures to a couple before	
actually doing so.	
The students need to know their own	
limitations as a Counselor. Couples who	
present needs that are beyond a	
Counselor's ability should refer the	
couple to another professional with	
appropriate training and experience.
